"The comparison of the miniature blots printed in gray colors along with the colored test blots makes it simple to decide whether the test blot makes a difference to the subject. Both the test blot and the achromatic blot (used for the localization of responses) can be shown to the subject side by side with the question: 'Disregarding the size, does this [pointing to the achromatic blot] look as much like a flower [or whatever response is being investigated] as this one [pointing to the test blot]?"
