

Clinical Scale Elevations

Scale(s) 7 (Pt)

T-score 70-84

Elevations on the present Scale(s), taking race, gender, age, education, marital and employment status into consideration for the corresponding group's data indicate any or all of these clinical features could be present in this person's behavior and history:

They are dissatisfied with their social relationships. They are not confident about what to expect from others, much less themselves. They are rigid, habit, hide bound, and self-critical. They cannot stop themselves from thinking unpleasant and frightening thoughts. They sweat the small things. They often overlook the most important parts of the "Big Picture." They often overlook salient features of a problem or social situation. They can feel "dumb" when they realize what they had missed or left out. They are meticulous about their work and person. They drive themselves hard to reach personally important goals. They are unusually persistent. Their rigid approach to life may intensify should they become ill, suffer accidents or injuries.
